### Introduction

E-Justice ODR Scheme project aimed at drafting an open specification which is necessary to start developing open e-justice platforms for different purposes in multiple countries which will be able to communicate with each other and exchange data and documents including in relation to the cross-border cases. This Open specification will be freely available to those who will design, develop and manage future easily interconnectable multi-lingual e-justice systems. The event will present the final results of the project, presenting the different facets that compose the open specifications. The event will also be the occasion for discussing the further avenues of research that may emerge considering the new legislative proposal on ODR package, as well as the use of AI in the delivery of justice.
